That same year (1994) the band, of which James was a member, was selected to perform as actors for the Toyota Corporation's Big Spring Sale.

Although he'd fallen in love with the art of voice over, music still held his heart hostage. Jim put voice overs on the back burner and continued to pursue his musical career.

In three decades of performing, James has played with and opened for such superstars as B.B. King, Ko Ko Taylor, Johnny Winter and War. In 2006, he released his first solo CD project entitled, "Best Kept Secret" where he had the #1 song for two weeks on Southern California radio. The CD also received rave reviews in both the U.S. and Europe.

Taking a hiatus from his musical career, James has recently graduated from American Broadcasting School. "I had the time of my life learning every aspect of the Broadcast industry." Jim said. "My instructors prepared me for a wonderful career...a career in the voice over industry!"
